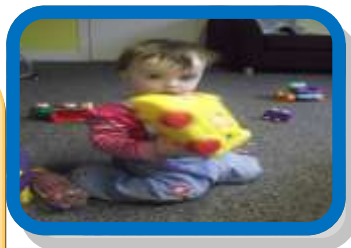

good for developing their sensory and motor skills.

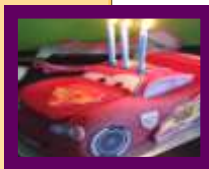
You may also have noticed we have a new member of staff in our room covering Emma while she is off on her maternity **leave. So we'd like to welcome**

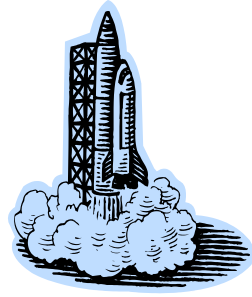
